


YEAR 7 ONLINE ENROLMENT GUIDE

Here is a guide to help you with the enrolment.


- 1. You will need to go to the school's website https://leeton-h.schools.nsw.gov.au//
- 2. Click on the **ENROLMENT** tab.




3. The following page will come up. Click on the online enrolment application.

Local enrolment area


Check your address on <u>School Finder</u> G to see if it is within our local intake area. Most schools have designated local enrolment areas. Note: local enrolment areas are subject to change.

How to enrol

If you are not able to apply online or you prefer not to, download the paper <u>application to enrol</u> (PDF 768.4KB) form. Please complete the form in English. A <u>translated application to enrol</u> of may help you do this.

Enrolment applications are finalised at the school.

- 4. Scroll down to Lets's start with the child's residential address.
- 5. Select the down arrow in the 'Enroling For' box and select the calendar year you are enrolling your student into e.g. 2025.
- 6. Select the down arrow in 'School Year to be enroled in'
- 7. Enter your address in the 'Childs's residential address box'.
- 8. If you are eligible to enrol an 'Apply to Enrol' button will appear, Click on this to continue.
- 9. Enter your **email address** and tick **'I'm not a robot'** box then **'Continue'** or **'Continue'** using your Service NSW account.
- 10. A verification code will be e-mailed to your e-mail address you entered. Enter this code and it will take you to the enrolment forms.
- 11. Fill in all the sections.
- 12. When completed and submitted the school will receive notification of your intent to enrol.
- 13. The following documentation can uploaded online or brought into the front office
 - Proof of student's identity (birth certificate, passport or NSW photo card)
 - Proof of student's residential address (utility bill, driver's licence or council rates notice)
- Student's immunisation history statement (obtainable via myGov)
- Student's passport, visa and travel documents (if student is not an Australian citizen)
- Student's medical/healthcare or emergency action plans
- Evidence of any disability or other support needs
- Family law or other relevant court orders
